MEMORANDUM FOR THE CHAIRMAN OF THE CREW DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE,
WAR SHIPPING ADMINISTRATION.

The Coast Guard has received from a reliable source information alleging that Solomon Levitson, O.S. on the SS MORMACMOON assaulted and struck the Chief Officer, Alexander Gronvall, on board ship 22 September, 1943, at the port of Buenos Aires. Levitson was placed in jail and returned to the MORMACMOON just prior to sailing on 24 September, 1943.

The Coast Guard will instigate whatever disciplinary action is warranted in this case.
