1. Position-Sea-Weather 34°15'S, 154°20'E; clear and slight sea.
2. Convoy or Independent Independent.
3. Time & Kind of 1st Hit 0613 - 1 torpedo.
4. Location of 1st Hit #4 hold starboard side.
5. Effect of 1st Hit Extensive damage to hull; small fire started in tween decks.
6. Time & Reason For Abandonment Or Why Not 0745 (1 hour, 32 min.) - ship considered due to sink; crew stood by to reboard.
7. Persons Aboard - 55 Lost - none.
8. Time & Kind of 2nd Hit 0740 (1 hour, 27 min.) - 1 torpedo.
9. Location of 2nd Hit #5 hold port side.
10. Effect of 2nd Hit Extensive damage.
11. Disposition of Vessel Sunk after an attempt was made to tow vessel 0335, 2/11/43 (21 hours, 22 min.)
