1. The STEPHEN JOHNSON FIELD was bombed by the enemy and damaged on 24 January, 1943, and although this vessel has since returned to the United States no survivors were interviewed as required by the above references.

2. Captain Pierce H. Powers is the senior survivor and still master of subject vessel. The STEPHEN JOHNSON FIELD is now at Chester, Pa., undergoing repairs. It is required that Capt. Powers be interviewed in conformance with the instructions contained in references (a), (b) and (c) while the subject vessel is in Chester, Pa.
