Approving the Sale Alien and Transfer to Honduran Registry and Flag of the Oil Screw TEAPA

IT IS ORDERED FURTHER, That this approval shall be null and void unless the sale alien, and the transfer to foreign registry and flag, hereby approved, are effected within six months of the date of such approval.
